City Council Special Meeting
September 16, 2024 at 6:30PM

The Guttenberg, Iowa City Council met in special session Monday, September 16, 2024 at 6:30 P.M. in the Municipal Building Council Chambers. Mayor Fred Schaub called the meeting to order with Roll Call and the Pledge of Allegiance. Council Present: Mandy Ludovissy, Jane Parker, Austin Greve, Michelle Geuder and Steve Bahls. Absent: None. Guests: Jessi Eulberg, Virginia Saeugling, and Kari Hoyheim.

Bahls made a motion to approve the agenda with the correction of eliminating agenda item 7. Parker seconded. Vote: Ayes: Ludovissy, Parker, Geuder, Bahls and Greve. Nay: 0. Motion Carried.

Bahls made a motion to approve Resolution No. 3427-24, A Resolution Approving Setting Public Hearing for the Status of Funded Activities for the City of Guttenberg Water Improvement Project at 6:00pm on October 14th. Geuder seconded. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, Geuder and Greve. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

Parker made a motion to approve Resolution No. 3428-24, A Resolution Approving the City of Guttenberg Alley Improvement Agreement (Block 6 PLP). Greve seconded. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, Geuder and Greve. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

Greve made a motion to approve Resolution No. 3431-24, A Resolution Approving the City of Guttenberg Alley Improvement Agreement (Block 14 PLP). Bahls seconded. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, Geuder and Greve. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

Discussed consider termination of shared employee agreement with Jessi Eulberg, VP of the Chamber Board. Chamber Board has approved terminating the agreement. Parker made a motion to approve terminating the shared employee agreement effective immediately. Bahls seconded. Vote: Ayes: Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, Geuder and Greve. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

Bahls made a motion to approve to go into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code section 21.5(1)(i) "to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session" Ludovissy seconded. Vote: Ayes: Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, Geuder and Greve. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

Council entered into closed session.

Parker made a motion to exit closed session. Greve seconded. Vote: Ayes: Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, Geuder and Greve. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

Bahls made a motion to terminate employment contract for shared employee. Parker seconded. Vote: Ayes: Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, Geuder and Greve. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

With no further business, Greve made a motion to adjourn at 7:04 p.m. Parker seconded. Vote: Ayes: Greve, Parker, Ludovissy, Bahls, and Geuder. Nays: 0. Motion carried.
