

CHAPTER 25

RECREATION BOARD

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25.01 BOARD CREATED. A Recreation Board is hereby created to advise the Council on recreation programs and activities and on the operation and maintenance of the swimming pool and other recreational facilities under the City’s control.

25.02 ORGANIZATION. The Board shall consist of five (5) members, and at least four (4) shall be residents of the City, and all residents of Clayton County, appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Council for overlapping three-year terms. The Board will elect its officers, such as Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary as it deems necessary. The position of any Board member shall be vacant if said member is absent from four (4) consecutive regular meetings of the Board, except in the case of sickness or temporary absence from the City. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments. The new member shall fill out the unexpired term for which the appointment is made. Terms shall expire on December 31.

25.03 JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY. The Board shall make recommendations to the City Council with regard to ongoing programs and the operation and maintenance of the parks and facilities under its jurisdiction, including: Guttenberg Swimming Pool and Horseshoe Pond Park area, Darwin Duwe Memorial Field and the Old Golf Course Park.

25.04 FEES. The Board shall recommend fees and charges to the Council for the use of the swimming pool and any other fees directly related to recreation programs.

25.05 REPORTS. At the Council’s request, the Recreation Board shall make program evaluation reports and budget requirements to the Council by the end of November each year. The Board may request expenditures related to the swimming pool or other recreational needs by submission of such request to the City Manager.

25.06 RULES. The Recreation Board shall recommend rules and regulations for the use of the swimming pool and other recreational facilities and programs. Copies of rules and regulations shall be provided to the Council and shall be posted to provide notice to the using public.
